

### TRIATHLON AT BLENHEIM PALACE

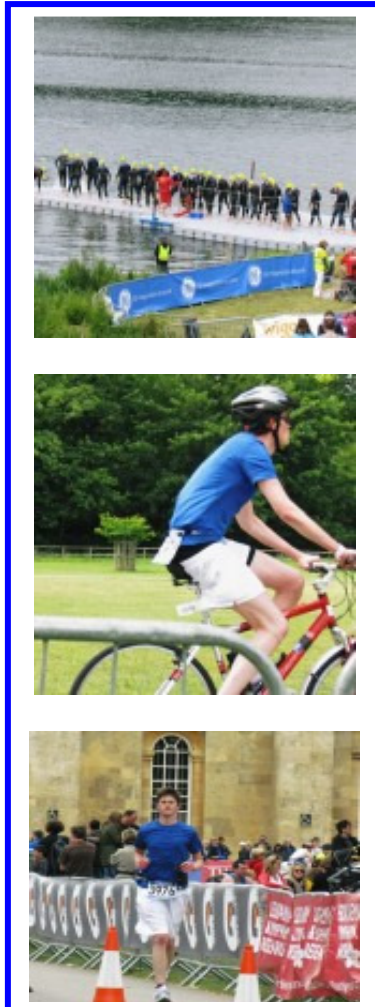
Sam Reid has completed the Blenheim Sprint Triathlon to raise money for the DTC's bursary programme. He has already raised over £4000.
